Just a short missive to point out a few changes.

Pregabalin *tablets* have entered the Tariff. These are Category A but all are more expensive than equivalent strengths of capsules.

Zolmitriptan 5mg tablets (Category C) have gone up 10-fold in price: from £3.60 to £36 for 6.

Cinacalcet tablets have moved from Category C to A with a 15% price reduction across all three strengths.

And finally, not a Part VIII but a part IX addition: Freestyle Libre *2*sensors. I think these are to be used with a different monitoring system which will provide alarms for low and high glucose levels. Same price as plain sensors at £35 each albeit with two wipes instead of one.
